Time and Location of Return: Nanitch participants - Saturday January 21st. – TCC 1:00pm

Timberline Snow Cave Only Participants - Sunday January 22nd, 2012 - TCC 1:00pm.

We will call as we get close to home if Early.

This year's snow event will have two separate themes. The first event will be spending the night at Nanitch Snow Lodge on Friday evening. We have reserved 40 spots at Nanitch Lodge. With one central commercial size kitchen we will be eating as a Troop. Nanitch offers inner tubing, snowshoeing, and building snow caves.

Nanitch Food Plan: Friday's dinner and Cracker Barrel, Saturday's breakfast and a grab and go lunch at Nanitch will be provided by the Troop.

The second part of this event will start Saturday after we part Nanitch Lodge. We will be traveling to Timberline Lodge where we will be building snow caves and spending the night in them. Only older Scouts who have completed the training should it and the second part of this event. This is extreme cold weather camping so proper preparation is required.

Snow Caving Food Plan: Saturday's dinner and Sunday's Breakfast will be personal / Patrol Style. Scouts should plan on using back pack style cooking.

Transportation and logistics will be critical for this event as we may have Scouts coming for the first part, Nanitch or the second part, Timberline or both.

Cost for Nanitch: To cover the cost of the Lodge & food there will be a \$20.00 fee per person.

Cost to cover Timberline snow caving event, NO COST.

Additionally, if you are driving a snow park permit will be required for Friday through Sunday.
